Strive to improve in your schoolwork by: achieving academic goals, completing classroom and homework assignments, and always trying
Partnership - Be Involved	Promote family involvement by providing families with activities that encourage the learning of reading, writing, math, and science.	Participate in decisions about your child's education via surveys, and visiting the website for volunteer opportunities.	Ensure parent/guardian receives all notes, fliers etc. Represent school with pride and excellence.
Communication - Stay Informed	Provide professional and positive feedback about student. Provide specific feedback to students in areas of growth. Teacher will hold conferences before, during or after school.	Keep an open line of communication between home and school	Deliver all notices and information you receive at school to an adult at home. Let your teacher and family know if you need help.
Learning Environment	Promote enthusiasm for learning by establishing a positive atmosphere.	Set a positive example for learning at home. Make sure my child attends school regularly and on time.	Show pride and enthusiasm for learning and for Eastside Elementary.
